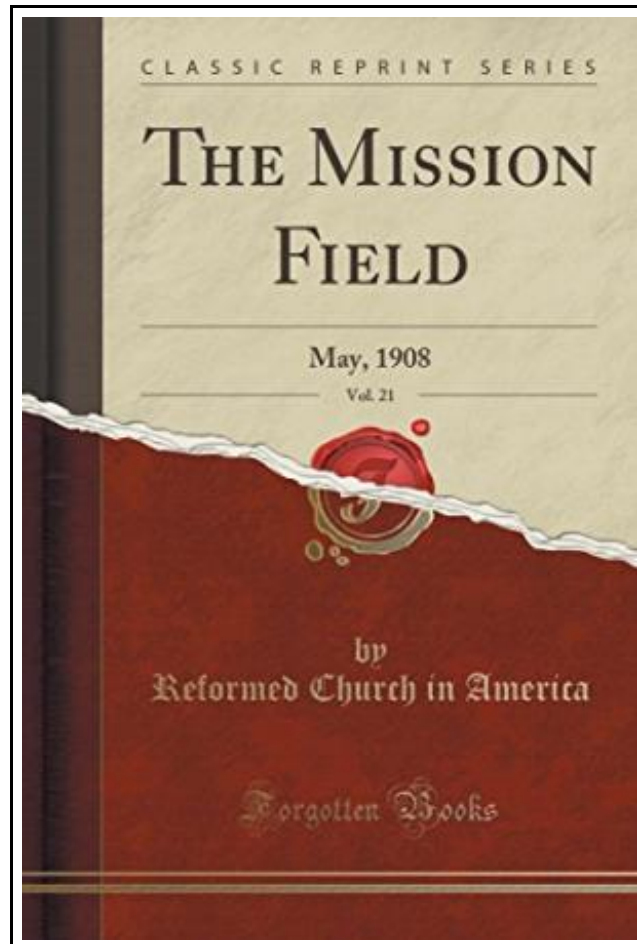

Twenty-four of these received baptism, ten of whom were children of the Church. Thus this church has grown from within and without, as all churches should grow. The pastor, Mr. Ng. who by the way will soon be made emeritus, gracefully gives all credit to his faithful people for this increase. But Mr. Ng has other good qualities besides modesty. He is a man strong in the faith, a forcible speaker, and a most devoted pastor. Unfortunately all these good things have been possessed by a weak body. Notwithstanding he has often been obliged to lessen his labors, yet for nearly a quarter of a century his life of consecration has been a power. The Kam-Un-Hoe (Missions of the Amoy City Churches) has done good work another year at Au-po and Ngo-hian-keng in the Tong-an region, and at Phai-bo on Amoy Island. Once a year the two churches meet to hold a thank-offering service (the words Kam-un-hoe mean a thank-offering church when they take up a collection for this particular Mission work. This year the meeting was held in the Tek-chhiu-kha church February 4th, and it was packed. The offering was \$370. It is expected that this amount will be increased to \$400. These two churches are doing much to extend the Kingdom. Besides this united work, each church has a mission of its own, the one at Che-chiu and the other at Khoe-hoa. One of these churches expends about \$1, 500 for maintenance of its activities - its own money. Mr. Harry A....
